RESOLUTION

**Impeaching Joseph Robinette Biden, President of the United States,
for high crimes, misdemeanors and dereliction of duty.**

Resolved, that Joseph Robinette Biden, President of the United States, is impeached for high crimes and misdemeanors and that the following articles of impeachment be exhibited to the United States Senate:

Articles of impeachment exhibited by the House of Representatives of the United States of America in the name of itself and of the people of the United States of America, against Joseph Robinette Biden, President of the United States of America, in maintenance and support of its impeachment against him for high crimes and misdemeanors.

ARTICLE I: ABUSE OF POWER

The Constitution provides that the House of Representatives “shall have the sole Power of Impeachment” and that the President “shall be removed from Office on Impeachment for, and Conviction of, Treason, Bribery, or other high Crimes and Misdemeanors”. In his conduct of the office of President of the United States — and in violation of his constitutional oath faithfully to execute the office of the President of the United States and, to the best of his ability, preserve, protect, and defend the Constitution of the United States, and in violation of his constitutional duty to take care that the laws be faithfully executed —, in that:

1) Using the powers of his former high office, then Vice-President Biden solicited the interference of a foreign government, Ukraine, in 2016 to have the government terminate the investigation into Burisma Holdings in which then Vice-President Biden's son, Hunter Biden, was implicated in a criminal investigation. He did so through a scheme or course of conduct that included soliciting the Government of Ukraine to fire the Prosecutor General. Then Vice-President Biden also sought to pressure the Government of Ukraine to take these steps by the condition of withholding from Ukraine a billion dollars in funds from the United States, a quid-pro-quo: an extortion admitted by then Vice-President Biden on video.

2) Using his powers of his former high office, then Vice-President Biden in 2013, allowed his son, Hunter, to accompany him on a trip to Beijing on Air Force 2. During the trip, the whereabouts of Hunter was kept secret, but in 10 days after the trip Hunter Biden's firm, Rosemont Seneca, made a \$1 Billion financial deal with the state-owned Bank of China, which was later increased to \$1.5 Billion. Hunter's firm was small and had no track record of similar financial deals. In subsequent interviews with a whistle-blower, allegedly 10% was allocated to the "Big Guy", reportedly then Vice-President Biden, in violation of the emoluments clause.

3) Using his powers of his current high office, President Biden has issued numerous and excessive Executive Orders in an overt attempt to circumvent the authority of the United States Congress, which includes a direct attempt to unlawfully change the United States Constitution, specifically the Second Amendment, contrary to his Constitutional obligation to defend and protect the Constitution, not change it.

4) Using his powers of his current high office, President Biden has made several public statements encouraging foreign nationals to surge the southern border of the United States with a promise of granting them citizenship and free public services without proper vetting and proper medical checks during a world-wide pandemic thus endangering the safety and lives of all Americans while disregarding warnings from numerous elected officials of numerous legislative bodies within the United States contrary to his oath of office to protect all lawful citizens of the United States.

5) Using his powers of his current high office, President Biden has attempted to change the demographic voter base by allowing illegal immigrants to remain in the United States and promising them citizenship in order to establish a right to ultimately vote, presumably Democrat, in the near future thus ensuring that the Democrat party will reign in perpetuity thus squashing any attempt of a bipartisan governance thus moving closer toward a Socialist/Marxist ruling party.

6) Using his powers of his current high office, President Biden has intentionally endangered the lives of American citizens by allowing illegal immigrants to enter the United States through his “open border” policy, during a pandemic, that are known to be carrying the Covid-19 virus without safeguards to protect said citizens and furthermore allowing the illegal immigrants to be transported to numerous locations throughout the United States in direct contradiction to Title 42 policy.

7) Using his powers of his current high office, President Biden has threatened the national and social security system of foreign sovereign nations by allowing illegal adult and minor immigrants to remain in the United States without any attempt to return those immigrants to their rightful nations thus depleting the foreign nations supply of its own citizens to support, protect and defend their nation. Depleting the foreign nations supply of its own citizens threatens the social security system of its elderly citizens by depleting the working class by eliminating financial support into their own respective country’s social security system.

8) Using his powers of his current high office, President Biden in January 2021, directed the Immigration and Customs Enforcement officials to violate federal immigration law(s) by directing them to stop all deportations of illegal immigrants by ignoring existing deportation orders by federal immigration judges. In so doing, President Biden has violated and undermined the authority of lawful federal authorities, which threatens the national security of the United States and puts American citizens at risk of harm. In late August 2021, the Supreme Court of the United States (SCOTUS) ruled that the Biden administration must return to the Trump policy that immigrants seeking asylum MUST remain in Mexico.

9) Using his powers of his current high office, President Biden on or about June 2021, knowingly allowed the Centers for Disease Control (CDC) to create a previously non-existent law to ban renters from being evicted for non-payment of rent. In early August 2021, President Biden once again knowingly allowed the CDC to extend the eviction which is in direct contradiction to a recent ruling by the SCOTUS. SCOTUS determined that the CDC did not have the legal authority to create any law, which is reserved to Congress as specified in the U.S. Constitution. In so doing, President Biden has abused his office to violate and undermine the lawful authority of a federal court, SCOTUS. In late August 2021, the Supreme Court of the United States ruled that the Biden eviction ban was unconstitutional.

ARTICLE II: DERELICTION OF DUTY

In August 2021, President Biden using his powers of Commander in Chief, directed the U.S. military to complete the mission of removing all military personnel from Afghanistan in the midst of impending threats from the Taliban, Al Qaeda and ISIS-K. In so doing, military personnel were evacuated prior to American citizens, Bagram Air Base was shuttered, \$85 Billion in weaponry including aircraft, uniforms, night-vision goggles and bullet-proof vests were left in-tact without an order to destroy said weaponry and other items. U.S. citizens and Afghan citizens with Special Immigration Visas were told to respond to the civilian airport in Kabul for evacuation, apparently without a clear evacuation plan other than to transport over a hundred thousand Afghans anywhere outside Afghanistan, which included potential known terrorists ultimately caught and identified in Saudi Arabia. Two suicide-bombers exploded killing 13 U.S. military personnel on August 26, 2021, even after the U.S. was made aware of an impending attack days before. It took President Biden approximately 9 hours to address the nation of the tragedy. In his speech, he blamed former President Trump for an agreement with the Taliban that kept the Taliban from attacking/injuring Americans for the past 18 months.

ARTICLE III: OBSTRUCTION OF JUSTICE

The Constitution provides that the House of Representatives “shall have the sole Power of Impeachment” and that the President “shall be removed from Office on Impeachment for, and Conviction of, Treason, Bribery, or other high Crimes and Misdemeanors”. In his conduct of the office of President of the United States — and in violation of his constitutional oath faithfully to execute the office of the President of the United States and, to the best of his ability, preserve, protect, and defend the Constitution of the United States, and in violation of his constitutional duty to take care that the laws be faithfully executed —, in that:

- 1) Using his powers of his former high office, former Vice-President Biden in 2018, directed the secret service to interfere into a lawful investigation into his son regarding the purchase of his son’s handgun whereas agents of the U.S. Secret Service attempted to unlawfully obtain original purchase documents from the gun dealer in an alleged attempt to destroy said documents which were found to contain a false statement by former Vice-President Biden’s son, Hunter Biden, on ATF form 4473, contrary to the Gun Control Act, 18 U.S.C. 921 et. seq. regarding his drug use.

2) President Biden made remarks several times to various reporters from different media outlets that he had no knowledge of his son's business dealings. Photographs have since been published that clearly show then Vice-President Biden photographed with his son Hunter Biden and two Mexican billionaire business men, which directly contradict President Biden's statements, thus implicating President Biden into alleged questionable pay-to-play payments, a quid-pro-quo.

ARTICLE IV: HIGH CRIMES

On August 26, 2021, it was revealed that the Biden Administration, during the chaotic evacuation of U.S. citizens and Afghans from Kabul, had provided to the Taliban a list of names of U.S. citizens and Afghan allies that needed safe passage to the airport. This is the same Taliban that the U.S. has been fighting for the past 20 years. In addition, it appears that upwards of 1,500 U.S. citizens will NOT be rescued and transported out of Afghanistan thus potentially signing their death warrants by leaving them at the hands of the Taliban. These acts of betraying U.S. citizens would appear to be an act of treason.

In all of this, President Biden has acted in a manner contrary to his trust as President and subversive of constitutional government, to the great prejudice of the cause of law and justice, and to the manifest injury of the people of the United States.

Wherefore, President Biden, by such conduct, has demonstrated that he will remain a threat to the Constitution if allowed to remain in office, and has acted in a manner grossly incompatible with self-governance and the rule of law, threatens the national security of the United States, the safety of American citizens and interfered into the national security of other foreign sovereign nations. President Biden thus warrants impeachment and trial, removal from office, and disqualification to hold and enjoy any office of honor, trust, or profit under the United States.
